We are excited to be bringing enhanced consultations for high-risk pregnancies and other new services tailored specifically for women. Our renewed emphasis on women's health will better meet the changing needs of women in the communities Marymount Hospital serves.

As part of our plan to better meet the communities' changing needs, we are transitioning the delivery of babies from Marymount Hospital to

Hillcrest and Fairview hospitals within our health system beginning July 1, 2011.

Women will still be able to get all of their care with their current physician conveniently at Marymount Hospital – only the hospital where a woman will give birth will change.

Women will now have the option to deliver their babies at two of Northeast Ohio's top performing birthing

centers at Hillcrest and Fairview hospitals. These hospitals have Level III Perinatal Centers and Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Units. This ensures your baby will receive the highest quality of care available for newborns.

Birthing services are also available at other Cleveland Clinic hospitals including Medina, Lakewood and Huron hospitals.

Hillcrest Hospital is located in Mayfield Heights, just 13 miles from Marymount Hospital. There were nearly 4,000 babies delivered at Hillcrest in 2010.

Hillcrest's labor and delivery unit features:

- 12 labor/delivery/recovery rooms and three specially-equipped operating rooms for Caesarean births
- 35 postpartum and high-risk rooms, including 26 private and nine semi-private rooms
- Highly-experienced obstetrical nurses and lactation consultants available seven days a week
- Cleveland Clinic Department of Maternal-Fetal Medicine for high risk pregnancies

Cleveland Clinic Children's Hospital Level III NICU at Hillcrest:

- Special Care Nursery with 24 private rooms
- Life-saving treatments and technologies for extremely premature newborns
- Healing, nurturing environment with light, noise and visitor controls
- Family room equipped with a kitchen, library, computers, play room for siblings, washer and dryer, and overnight stay rooms with hotel-like accommodations for parents

Fairview Hospital is located in Cleveland, just 15 miles from Marymount Hospital. There were more than 4,300 babies delivered at Fairview in 2010.

Fairview's labor and delivery unit features:

- 13 labor/delivery/recovery rooms and three specially-equipped operating rooms for Caesarean births
- 44 private postpartum rooms and two semi-private rooms, and 13 high-risk rooms
- Highly-experienced obstetrical nurses and lactation consultants available seven days a week
- Cleveland Clinic Department of Maternal-Fetal Medicine for high risk pregnancies

Cleveland Clinic Children's Hospital Level III NICU at Fairview:

- Neonatal Intensive Care Nursery with 26 beds
- Life-saving treatments and technologies for extremely premature newborns
- Healing, nurturing environment with light, noise and visitor controls
- Ronald McDonald Family Room equipped with a kitchen, library, computers, TV, toys, showers and food
